(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On Wednesday 19 July 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway reconstruction works) on Church Lane, Coatbridge from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Crichton Street and St John Street, a distance of 90 metres, or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed northwards along Church Street, eastwards on Albert Street and southwards on Crichton Street to the east side of the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 31 July 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 17 September 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Church Lane, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirty-first day of July, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the seventeenth day of September, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway reconstruction works) on Church Lane, Coatbridge from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Crichton Street and St John Street, a distance of 90 metres, or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed northwards along Church Street, eastwards on Albert Street and southwards on Crichton Street to the east side of the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
