Laxford Place, Coatbridge

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 19 July 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on cabling works) on Laxford Place, Coatbridge from its junction with Paddock Street northwards for a distance of 25 metres, or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed northwards on Laxford Place, generally northwards on Strathmore Walk, north-eastwards on Sikeside Place, south-eastwards and southwards on Sikeside Street, then westwards on Paddock Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 29 July 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 2 August 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Laxford Place, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the twenty-ninth day of July, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the second of August, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on cabling works) on Laxford Place, Coatbridge from its junction with Paddock Street northwards for a distance of 25 metres, or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed northwards on Laxford Place, northwards, generally northwards on Strathmore Walk, north-eastwards on Sikeside Place, south-eastwards and southwards on Sikeside Street, then westwards on Paddock Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
