B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, Viewpark

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 21 September 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway reconstruction works) on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, Viewpark from a point 20 metres west of the extended east kerblines of St Bride's Avenue, eastwards to its junction with the Laburnum Road roundabout by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

The closure will only be effective when displayed by signs and should last a maximum of approximately 7 days.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed westwards on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, southwards on Spindlehowe Road, eastwards on A721 New Edinburgh Road to the A725 roundabout exiting westwards on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road to the east point of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access St Bride's Avenue should proceed westwards on Old Edinburgh Road, northwards on Elmbank Avenue and eastwards on Douglas Street to St Bride's Avenue.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access St Bride's Avenue should proceed eastwards on Old Edinburgh Road to the A725 roundabout, westwards on New Edinburgh Road, northwards on Spindlehowe Road, eastwards on Old Edinburgh Road, northwards on Elmbank Avenue, eastwards on Douglas Street to St Bride's Avenue.

Vehicles wishing to access Old Edinburgh Road from St Bride's Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 2 October 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 24 December 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, Viewpark) (Temporary Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the second day of October, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-fourth day of December, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, Viewpark from a point 20 metres west of the extended east kerblines of St Bride’s Avenue, eastwards to its junction with the Laburnum Road roundabout by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

The closure will only be effective when displayed by signs and should last a maximum of approximately 7 days.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed westwards on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road, southwards on Spindlehowe Road, eastwards on A721 New Edinburgh Road to the A725 roundabout exiting westwards on B7001 Old Edinburgh Road to the east point of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access St Bride’s Avenue should proceed westwards on Old Edinburgh Road, northwards on Elmbank Avenue and eastwards on Douglas Street to St Bride’s Avenue.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access St Bride’s Avenue should proceed eastwards on Old Edinburgh Road to the A725 roundabout, westwards on New Edinburgh Road, northwards on Spindlehowe Road, eastwards on Old Edinburgh Road, northwards on Elmbank Avenue, eastwards on Douglas Street to St Bride’s Avenue.

Vehicles wishing to access Old Edinburgh Road from St Bride’s Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
