B7057 Shotts Road and B7066 Hirst Road, Harthill, Shotts

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 4 October 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on junction improvement works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions associated with the junction improvement. Each phase of the closure will only be valid when the appropriate signing is in place.

Phase 1

B7066 Hirst Road from a point 12 metres southwestwards of the extended line of the west kerb of B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) to a point 90 metres northwestwards of the extended line of the east kerb of B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) and B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) from its junction with B7066 Hirst Road continuing northwestwards for a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Phase 2

B7057 Shotts Road, Harthill, Shotts (south of Hirst Road) from its junction with B7066 Hirst Road, continuing south-eastwards for a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:

Phase 1

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on B7057 Shotts Road, northeastwards on B717 West Benhar Road and southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the M8 should proceed northeastwards on B7066 Hirst Road/Edinburgh Road/West Main Street/East Main Street, northwards and northeastwards on A706 Armadale Road, southeastwards on A801 to the M8 slip road.

Vehicles travelling westwards on the M8 wishing to exit via the slip road onto the B7057 Shotts Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the M8 should proceed southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road/Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, northwestwards on Sandielands Avenue to the M8 slip road.

Vehicles travelling on the M8 wishing to exit via the slip road onto the B7057 Shotts Road should proceed vice versa.

Phase 2

Vehicles travelling southwestwards on B7066 wishing to turn left onto B7057 Shotts Road should continue southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road, south-eastwards on Newmill and Canthill Road, south-eastwards on Shottskirk Road, northeastwards on Calderhead Road to B7057 Shotts Road.

Vehicles travelling northeastwards on B7066 Hirst Road wishing to turn right into Shotts Road should proceed northeastwards on B7066, southwestwards on B717 West Benhar Road and northwestwards on B7057 Shotts Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B717 Benhar Road wishing to proceed on B7057 Shotts Road and turn left onto B7066 Hirst Road should proceed southwestwards on Calderhead Road, north-westwards on Shottskirk Road, north-westwards and northwards on Newmill and Canthill Road to B7066 Hirst Road.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B717 Benhar Road wishing to proceed on B7057 Shotts Road and turn right onto B7066 Hirst Road should proceed north-eastwards on B717 West Benhar Road to B7066 Hirst Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 14 October 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 12 November 2006.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B7057 Shotts Road and B7066 Hirst Road, Harthill, Shotts) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the fourteenth day of October, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twelfth day of November, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on junction improvement works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions associated with the junction improvement. Each phase of the closure will only be valid when the appropriate signing is in place.

Phase 1

B7066 Hirst Road from a point 12 metres southwestwards of the extended line of the west kerb of B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) to a point 90 metres northwestwards of the extended line of the east kerb of B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) and B7057 Shotts Road (north of Hirst Road) from its junction with B7066 Hirst Road continuing northwestwards for a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Phase 2

B7057 Shotts Road, Harthill, Shotts (south of Hirst Road) from its junction with B7066 Hirst Road, continuing south-eastwards for a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:

Phase 1

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on B7057 Shotts Road, northeastwards on B717 West Benhar Road and southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the M8 should proceed northeastwards on B7066 Hirst Road/Edinburgh Road/West Main Street/East Main Street, northwards and northeastwards on A706 Armadale Road, southeastwards on A801 to the M8 slip road.

Vehicles travelling westwards on the M8 wishing to exit via the slip road onto the B7057 Shotts Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the M8 should proceed southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road/Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, northwestwards on Sandielands Avenue to the M8 slip road.

Vehicles travelling on the M8 wishing to exit via the slip road onto the B7057 Shotts Road should proceed vice versa.

Phase 2

Vehicles travelling southwestwards on B7066 wishing to turn left onto B7057 Shotts Road should continue southwestwards on B7066 Hirst Road, south-eastwards on Newmill and Canthill Road, south-eastwards on Shottskirk Road, northeastwards on Calderhead Road to B7057 Shotts Road.

Vehicles travelling northeastwards on B7066 Hirst Road wishing to turn right into Shotts Road should proceed northeastwards on B7066, southwestwards on B717 West Benhar Road and northwestwards on B7057 Shotts Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B717 Benhar Road wishing to proceed on B7057 Shotts Road and turn left onto B7066 Hirst Road should proceed southwestwards on Calderhead Road, north-westwards on Shottskirk Road, north-westwards and northwards on Newmill and Canthill Road to B7066 Hirst Road.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B717 Benhar Road wishing to proceed on B7057 Shotts Road and turn right onto B7066 Hirst Road should proceed north-eastwards on B717 West Benhar Road to B7066 Hirst Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.
