**Footpath connecting Scott Street to Merry Street, Motherwell and  
One Way Order for Park Street and Scott Street, Motherwell**

**(Temporary Restriction of Pedestrian Movement and Temporary Road  
Closure) Order 2006**

On 18 October 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of persons engaged on sewerage connection works) on the footpath commencing at the south west side of Scott Street, continuing northwards for a distance of 160 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Scott Street for 80 metres or thereby, north westwards on a designated safe route through the site for a distance of 50 metres or thereby, south westwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby, then north westwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby to the north side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the north side of the closure to proceed vice versa.*

The order will also temporarily invoke a One Way Order on Scott Street from its junction with Dalziel Street, continuing south westwards then south eastwards on Park Street to the extended western kerbline of Coursington Road.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on Park Street wishing to continue north westwards beyond the extended western kerbline of Coursington Road to proceed north eastwards on Coursington Road, then north westwards on Dalziel Street and south westwards on Scott Street to the north east side of the closure.*

Both the closure of the footpath and temporary traffic Order shall only be effective when diversion signing and traffic management is in place.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Wednesday, 18 October 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 23 September 2007.

### Footpath connecting Scott Street to Merry Street, Motherwell and One Way Order for Park Street and Scott Street, Motherwell

#### (Temporary Restriction of Pedestrian Movement and Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Footpath connecting Scott Street to Merry Street, Motherwell and One Way Order for Park Street and Scott Street, Motherwell) (Temporary Restriction of Pedestrian Movement and Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the eighteenth day of October, Two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty third day of September Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall be permitted to proceed on foot (with the exception of persons engaged on sewerage connection works) on the footpath commencing at the south west side of Scott Street, continuing northwards for a distance of 160 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Scott Street for 80 metres or thereby, north westwards on a designated safe route through the site for a distance of 50 metres or thereby, south westwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby, then north westwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby to the north side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the north side of the closure to proceed vice versa.*

The Order will also temporarily invoke a One Way Order on Scott Street from its junction with Dalziel Street, continuing south westwards then south eastwards on Park Street to the extended western kerblines of Coursington Road.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north westwards on Park Street wishing to continue north westwards beyond the extended western kerblines of Coursington Road to proceed north eastwards on Coursington Road, then north westwards on Dalziel Street and south westwards on Scott Street to the north east side of the closure.*

Both the closure of the footpath and temporary traffic Order shall only be effective when diversion signing and traffic management is in place.
