

North Lanarkshire Council
Wallace Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2006

On 1 November 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water's flood alleviation scheme) on Wallace Street from its junction with Dundyvan Road to its junction with Hozier Street by reason of works being executed on or near this location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street, north-eastwards on Newlands Street and eastwards on Hozier Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 13 November 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 22 December 2006.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Wallace Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of November, two thousand and six until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-second day of December, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water’s flood alleviation scheme) on Wallace Street from its junction with Dundyvan Road to its junction with Hozier Street by reason of works being executed on or near this location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street, north-eastwards on Newlands Street and eastwards on Hozier Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
