Un-named Footpath Smithstone Road to Constarry Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006

On 2 November 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot with the exception of persons engaged on footpath reconstruction works (on the un-named footpath from its junction with Smithstone Road north-westwards, north-eastwards then south-eastwards to its junction with Constarry Road) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south side of the closure on Smithstone Road to proceed eastwards on Smithstone Road to Balloch Roundabout then northwards on Constarry Road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrians at the east side of the closure on Constarry Road to proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0800 hours on Monday, 13 November 2006 and will remain in operation until 1700 hours on Monday, 30 April 2007.

Un-named Footpath Smithstone Road to Constarry Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named Footpath Smithstone Road to Constarry Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0800 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of November, two thousand and six, until 1700 hours on Monday, the thirtieth day of April, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of persons engaged on footpath reconstruction works on the un-named footpath from its junction with Smithstone Road north-westwards, north-eastwards then south-eastwards to its junction with Constarry Road) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south side of the closure on Smithstone Road to proceed eastwards on Smithstone Road to Balloch Roundabout then northwards on Constarry Road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrians at the east side of the closure on to proceed vice versa.
