(Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2006

On 2 November 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in excess of one hour with return prohibited within three hours between 0700 hours and 1800 hours Monday to Friday, at the Parking Area, Constarry Road, Cumbernauld at its junction with Barbegs Crescent, Croy by reason of the need to make the parking area available for use throughout the day and safeguard the public.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 13 November 2006 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Monday, 31 December 2007.

(Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Constarry Road, Croy) (Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of November, Two thousand and six, until 2359 hours on Monday, the thirty-first day of December, Two thousand and seven.
2. It is unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in excess of one hour with return prohibited within three hours between 0700 hours and 1800 hours Monday to Friday at the Parking Area, Constarry Road, Cumbernauld at its junction with Barbegs Crescent, Croy by reason of the need to make the parking area available for use throughout the day and safeguard the public.
