

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**B804 Main Street, Glenboig**  
**(Temporary Closure) Order 2006**

On 8 November 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on rail bridge abutment repair works) on the B804 Main Street, Glenboig from the extended line of the west kerb of Glenboig New Road for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed south on the B804 Coatbridge Road onto Coltswood Road, westwards on the B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards on Gartsherrie Road onto Townhead Road, northwards on the A752 Coatbridge Road onto Lochend Road, eastwards on the B804 Johnston Road onto Main Street to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 2300 hours on Monday, 20 November 2006 and will remain in operation until 0630 hours on Monday, 27 November 2006.

**(Temporary Closure) Order 2006**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B804 Main Street, Glenboig) (Temporary Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 2300 hours on Monday, the twentieth day of November, Two thousand and six until 0630 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of November, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on rail bridge abutment repair works) on the B804 Main Street, Glenboig from the extended line of the west kerb of Glenboig New Road for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed southwards on the B804 Coatbridge Road onto Coltswood Road, westwards on the B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards on Gartsherrie Road onto Townhead Road, northwards on the A752 Coatbridge Road onto Lochend Road and eastwards on the B804 Johnston Road onto Main Street to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
