Motherwell Road, Bellshill

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 9 November 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on upgrading the existing signalised pedestrian crossing) on the A721 Motherwell Road, Bellshill from its junction with Belvidere Road south eastwards for a distance of 46 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles at the south side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Motherwell Road, south westwards on Alice Avenue, south eastwards on Crossgates, continuing south eastwards on A721 Motherwell Road, north eastwards and northwards on Calder Road, westwards, north westwards, then westwards on A775 Main Street/Campbell Street, southwards on A721 North Road/B7070 Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates, north eastwards on Belvidere Road to the north point of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The County of Lanark (Motherwell Road and Crossgates, Bellshill) (One Way Traffic) Order 1963 will be temporarily revoked as part of this temporary traffic regulation order.

The Order will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 20 November 2006 and will remain in operation until 0930 hours on Saturday 25 November 2006 or until the works are completed whichever is the lesser.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Motherwell Road, Bellshill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0930 hours on Monday the twentieth day of November 2006, until 0930 hours on Saturday the twenty fifth day of November, Two thousand and six.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on upgrading the existing signalised pedestrian crossing) on the A721 Motherwell Road, Bellshill from its junction with Belvidere Road south eastwards for a distance of 46 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes:

Vehicles at the south side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Motherwell Road, south westwards on Alice Avenue, south eastwards on Crossgates, continuing south eastwards on A721 Motherwell Road, north eastwards and northwards on Calder Road, westwards, north westwards, then westwards on A775 Main Street/Campbell Street, southwards on A721 North Road/B7070 Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates, north eastwards on Belvidere Road to the north point of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The County of Lanark (Motherwell Road and Crossgates, Bellshill) (One Way Traffic) Order 1963 will be temporarily revoked as part of this temporary traffic regulation order.
