Traquair Avenue, Coltness, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

On 20 December 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the renewal of an existing gas main) on Traquair Avenue, Coltness, Wishaw by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase associated with the renewal of an existing gas main. Each phase will take place at a different time.

Phase 1 – Traquair Avenue

From its junction with Coltness Road northeastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of the eastern junction of Tweed Crescent.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Coltness Road, north eastwards on Greenlaw Avenue, north westwards on Stobo Street and south westwards on Traquair Avenue to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice-versa.

Phase 2 – Traquair Avenue

From the extended line of the western kerblines of the eastern junction of Tweed Crescent north eastwards and northwards to its junction with Kilmeny Crescent.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Traquair Avenue, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south eastwards on Hazeldean Crescent and southwards and south eastwards on Kilmeny Crescent to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to properties on Traquair Avenue, Coltness will be maintained on arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained for the entire duration of the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 8 January 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday 25 February 2007.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Traquair Avenue, Coltness) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2006” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighth day of January, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of February, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the renewal of an existing gas main) on Traquair Avenue, Coltness, Wishaw by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The appropriate diversion signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase associated with the renewal of an existing gas main. Each phase will take place at a different time.

Phase 1 – Traquair Avenue

From its junction with Coltness Road northeastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of the eastern junction of Tweed Crescent.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Coltness Road, north eastwards on Greenlaw Avenue, north westwards on Stobo Street and south westwards on Traquair Avenue to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice-versa.

Phase 2 – Traquair Avenue

From the extended line of the western kerblines of the eastern junction of Tweed Crescent north eastwards and northwards to its junction with Kilmeny Crescent.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Traquair Avenue, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south eastwards on Hazeldean Crescent and southwards and south eastwards on Kilmeny Crescent to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
