

North Lanarkshire Council
Hozier Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2006

On 27 December 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water's Flood Alleviation Project) on Hozier Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street eastwards to its junction with the A725 Whifflet Street, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Wallace Street, north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road and southwards on Whifflet Street to the east side of the closure.

As Hozier Street is a one way street, there is no requirement for an alternative route for vehicles on the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 8 January 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday 16 February 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hozier Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighth day of January, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Friday, the sixteenth day of February, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water’s Flood Alleviation Project) on Hozier Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street eastwards to its junction with the A725 Whifflet Street, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Wallace Street, north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road and southwards on Whifflet Street to the east side of the closure.

As Hozier Street is a one way street, there is no requirement for an alternative route for vehicles on the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.
