(Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2007

On 28 December 2006 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 0730 hours until 0930 hours and 1430 hours until 1630 hours Monday to Friday on Dowanfield Road, Seafar, Cumbernauld from its junction with Seafar Road, south-westwards then north-westwards for a distance of 346 metres or thereby, on both sides of the carriageway by reason of the need to maintain access to the school during construction works.

The Order, will come into operation at 0730 hours on Monday 8 January 2007 and will remain in operation until 1630 hours on Monday 30 June 2008.

(Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Dowanfield Road, Seafar, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Waiting Restriction) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0730 hours on Monday, the eighth day of January, two thousand and seven until 1630 hours on Monday, the thirtieth day of June, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 0730 hours until 0930 hours and 1430 hours until 1630 hours Monday to Friday on Dowanfield Road, Seafar, Cumbernauld from its junction with Seafar Road, south-westwards then north-westwards for a distance of 346 metres or thereby, on both sides of the carriageway by reason of the need to maintain access to the school during construction works.
