

North Lanarkshire Council
Crown Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 10 January 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on kerb and footway resurfacing works) on Crown Street, Coatbridge from its junction Kildonan Street south-westwards to its junction with Clyde Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on the north side of the closure should proceed westwards on Kildonan Street, southwards on Park Street and south-eastwards on Clyde Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the north side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Kildonan Street, south-westwards on Lavelle Drive and north-westwards on Clyde Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practical.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 22 January 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 9 February 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Crown Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of January, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Friday, the ninth day of February, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on kerb and footway resurfacing works) on Crown Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Kildonan Street south-westwards to its junction with Clyde Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on the north side of the closure should proceed westwards on Kildonan Street, southwards on Park Street and south-eastwards on Clyde Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling eastwards on the north side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Kildonan Street, south-westwards on Lavelle Drive and north-westwards on Clyde Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.
