(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On 17 January 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new kerbing and footway resurfacing works) on Narvar Court, Shotts from its junction with Shiel Gardens to its termination by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Vehicular access to properties on Narvar Court to be maintained on arrangement with the contractor. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 29 January 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 25 February 2007.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Narvar Court, Shotts) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-ninth day of January, Two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of February, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on new kerbing and footway resurfacing works) on Narvar Court, Shotts from its junction with Shiel Gardens to its termination by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
