Main Street and Market Street, Kilsyth
(Temporary One Way) Order 2007

On 7 March 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of emergency service vehicles) in the manner specified below by reason of road safety issues on the undernoted locations.

Main Street, Kilsyth (Prohibited Direction of Travel – North-westwards)

Main Street, Kilsyth from its junction with East Burnside Street south-eastwards to the extended line of the southern boundary wall of number 2 Main Street, a distance of 210 metres or thereby.

Market Street, Kilsyth (Prohibited Direction of Travel - South-westwards)

Market Street, Kilsyth from the extended line of the eastern boundary wall of numbers 1 and 3 Main Street north-eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of the west access to Market Square car park, a distance of 34 metres or thereby.

There are no alternative routes available.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 19 March 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 17 August 2008.

(Temporary One Way) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street and Market Street, Kilsyth) (Temporary One Way) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of March, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the seventeenth day of August, two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of emergency service vehicles) in the manner specified below by reason of road safety issues on the undernoted locations.

Main Street, Kilsyth (Prohibited Direction of Travel – North-westwards)

Main Street, Kilsyth from its junction with East Burnside Street south-eastwards to the extended line of the southern boundary wall of number 2 Main Street, a distance of 210 metres or thereby.

Market Street, Kilsyth (Prohibited Direction of Travel - South-westwards)

Market Street, Kilsyth from the extended line of the eastern boundary wall of numbers 1 and 3 Main Street north-eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of the west access to Market Square car park, a distance of 34 metres or thereby.
