Nisbet Street, Lawhope Mill Road & Gartness Road, Chapelhall

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 7 March 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing, kerbing and drainage works and the erection of vehicular safety barrier) on Nisbet Street, Lawhope Mill Road & Gartness Road from the junction of Nisbet Street with the A73 Main Street to the junction of Gartness Road with Craigens Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling north-westwards should proceed north-westwards on A73 Main Street, northwards on Burniebrae Road, north-eastwards then eastwards on Bowhousebrae Road, eastwards then south-eastwards on Craigens Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure travelling north-westwards should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling south-eastwards should proceed south-eastwards on A73 Main Street and A73 Bellside Road to Newhouse Interchange, southwards on A73 Bellside Road, eastwards on A7066 Hirst Road, northwards then north-eastwards on Bothwellshields Road and north-westwards on Craigens Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure travelling south-eastwards should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable.

Vehicular access to properties within the closure will be maintained where practicable.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 19 March 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 13 April 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Nisbet Street, Lawhope Mill Road & Gartness Road, Chapelhall) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of March, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Friday, the thirteenth day of April, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing, kerbing and drainage works and the erection of vehicular safety barrier) on Nisbet Street, Lawhope Mill Road & Gartness Road from the junction of Nisbet Street with the A73 Main Street to the junction of Gartness Road with Craigens Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling north-westwards should proceed north-westwards on A73 Main Street, northwards on Burniebrae Road, north-eastwards then eastwards on Bowhousebrae Road, eastwards then south-eastwards on Craigens Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure travelling north-westwards should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling south-eastwards should proceed south-eastwards on A73 Main Street and A73 Bellside Road to Newhouse Interchange, southwards on A73 Bellside Road, eastwards on A7066 Hirst Road, northwards then north-eastwards on Bothwellshields Road and north-westwards on Craigens Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure travelling south-eastwards should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable.

Vehicular access to properties within the closure will be maintained where practicable.
