

## North Lanarkshire Council

### Dundyvan Road & Barrowfield Street, Coatbridge

#### (Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 21 March 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Scottish Water Flood Alleviation Project) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

#### Closure 1

Dundyvan Road from the extended line of the western kerb of Newlands Street to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Exeter Street.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south-eastwards and eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, southwards on A725 Coatbank Street, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street and westwards on Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*All vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Barrowfield Street should proceed eastwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street, westwards on School Street to Barrowfield Street.*

*All vehicles on Barrowfield Street wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, westwards on A89 Glasgow Road, westwards on A89 Coatbridge Road, south-eastwards on A752 Langmuir Road, eastwards on A8 Glasgow-Edinburgh Trunk Road, northwards on A725 Whifflet Street and westwards on Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Pedestrian access will be maintained.*

*Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.*

## Closure 2

Barrowfield Street from its junction with Dundyvan Road southwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south-eastwards and eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, southwards on A725 Coatbank Street, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street, south-westwards on School Street and north-westwards and north-westwards and north-eastwards on Barrowfield Street to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, westwards on A89 Glasgow Road, westwards A89 Coatbridge Road, south-eastwards on A752 Langmuir Road, eastwards on A8 Glasgow – Edinburgh Trunk Road, northwards on A725 Whifflet Street, south-westwards on School Street, north-westwards and north-eastwards on Barrowfield Street to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 2 April 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 20 May 2007.

#### (Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Dundyvan Road & Barrowfield Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the second day of April, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twentieth day of May, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Scottish Water Flood Alleviation Project) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

#### Closure 1

Dundyvan Road from the extended line of the western kerb of Newlands Street to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Exeter Street.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south-eastwards and eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, southwards on A725 Coatbank Street, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street and westwards on Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*All vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to Barrowfield Street should proceed eastwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street, westwards on School Street to Barrowfield Street.*

*All vehicles on Barrowfield Street wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on*

*B753 Dundyvan Road, south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, westwards on A89 Glasgow Road, westwards on A89 Coatbridge Road, south-eastwards on A752 Langmuir Road, eastwards on A8 Glasgow-Edinburgh Trunk Road, northwards on A725 Whifflet Street and westwards on Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Pedestrian access will be maintained.*

*Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.*

## Closure 2

Barrowfield Street from its junction with Dundyvan Road southwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south-eastwards and eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, southwards on A725 Coatbank Street, southwards on A725 Whifflet Street, south-westwards on School Street and north-westwards and north-westwards and north-eastwards on Barrowfield Street to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (4.9 metres or 16' 3" or less in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on B753 Dundyvan Road, south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, westwards on A89 Glasgow Road, westwards A89 Coatbridge Road, south-eastwards on A752 Langmuir Road, eastwards on A8 Glasgow – Edinburgh Trunk Road, northwards on A725 Whifflet Street, south-westwards on School Street, north-westwards and north-eastwards on Barrowfield Street to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles (exceeding 4.9 metres or 16' 3" in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Pedestrian access will be maintained.*

*Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.*
