Various Streets, Central Area
(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 2 May 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) over the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Central Area) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourteenth day of May, Two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirtieth day of September, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) over the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.
