Coltness Bridge, Coltness Road/Wishaw High Road, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On 23 May 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge strengthening works) at Coltness Bridge (over its entire length), where Coltness Road meets Wishaw High Road, Wishaw by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes:

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed northwards and north-westwards on Wishaw High Road, north-eastwards on Main Street, eastwards on Bellside Road, south-eastwards on A73 Westwood Road, south-westwards on Manse Road, westwards on Cambusnethan Street, westwards on Kirk Road, and north-westwards then northwards on Coltness Road to the southside of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 4 June 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 14 December 2007.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Coltness Bridge, Coltness Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the Fourth Day of June, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Friday, the Fourteenth Day of December, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Bridge Strengthening Works) at Coltness Bridge (over its entire length), where Coltness Road meets Wishaw High Road, Wishaw by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes:

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed northwards and north-westwards on Wishaw High Road, north-eastwards on Main Street, eastwards on Bellside Road, south-eastwards on A73 Westwood Road, south-westwards on Manse Road, westwards on Cambusnethan Street, westwards on Kirk Road, and north-westwards then northwards on Coltness Road to the southside of the closure.
