

North Lanarkshire Council
Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On 1 August 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on footway resurfacing works) on Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge from its junction with Main Street, South Circular Road, Bank Street and West Canal Street roundabout, northwards to the extended line of the south kerb of Baird Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and eastwards on the A89 South Circular Road, north-westwards on the B804 Main Street, northwards on the B804 Dunbeth Road, and south-westwards on the B803 Sunnyside Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Vehicular access to properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours until 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays only from Sunday, 12 August 2007 until Sunday, 26 August 2007.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours until 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays only from Sunday, the twelfth day of August, two thousand and seven until Sunday, the twenty-sixth day of August, two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on footway resurfacing works) on Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge from its junction with Main Street, South Circular Road, Bank Street and West Canal Street roundabout, northwards to the extended line of the south kerb of Baird Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and eastwards on the A89 South Circular Road, north-westwards on the B804 Main Street, northwards on the B804 Dunbeth Road, and south-westwards on the B803 Sunnyside Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Vehicular access to properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.
