### A89 Bank Street, Blairhill Street and Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge

#### (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On 22 August 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

#### Location 1

A89 Bank Street, Coatbridge from its junction with the A89 Bank Street Roundabout to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Manse Street.

#### Location 2

Blairhill Street/Dundyvan Road from the extended line of the south-western kerb of West Canal Street to the extended line of the north-eastern kerb of Buchanan Street.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road, eastwards and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road then south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dundyvan Road wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road, north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards and westwards on Gartsherrie Road, southwards on Blair Road then north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street to the south-west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dudyvan Road wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street then westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dundyvan Road wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road, north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards and westwards on Gartsherrie Road, southwards on Blair Road then south-eastwards on King Street to Blairhill Street.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed south-westwards on Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road then south-eastwards on King Street to Blairhill Street.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on King Street, northwards on Blair Road, eastwards and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road then south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours until 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays only from Sunday, 2 September 2007 until Sunday, 16 September 2007.

### A89 Bank Street, Blairhill Street and Dundyvan Road, Coatbridge

#### (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A89 Bank Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours to 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays only from Sunday, the second day of September, two thousand and seven until Sunday, the sixteenth day of September, two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on the undernoted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

#### Location 1

A89 Bank Street, Coatbridge from its junction with the A89 Bank Street Roundabout to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Manse Street.

#### Location 2

Blairhill Street/Dundyvan Road from the extended line of the south-western kerb of West Canal Street to the extended line of the north-eastern kerb of Buchanan Street.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A89 Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road, eastwards and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road then south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dundyvan Road wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road, north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards and westwards on Gartsherrie Road, southwards on Blair Road then north-eastwards on A89 Bank Street to the south-west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dudyvan Road wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street then westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Dundyvan Road wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Dundyvan Road, northwards on Whifflet Street, northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards and north-westwards on South Circular Road, north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-westwards and westwards on Gartsherrie Road, southwards on Blair Road then south-eastwards on King Street to Blairhill Street.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to Dundyvan Road should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed south-westwards on Bank Street, northwards on Blair Road then south-eastwards on King Street to Blairhill Street.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Blairhill Street wishing to travel to the north-east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on King Street, northwards on Blair Road, eastwards and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road then south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to travel to Blairhill Street should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
