(Temporary Closure) Order No.2 2007

On 22 August 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water's Flood Alleviation Scheme) on Hozier Street from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street to its junction with Whifflet Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed northwestwards on Wallace Street then eastwards on B753 Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in operation at this location by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on 30 May 2007, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Sunday, 2 September 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 28 October 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order No.2 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Hozier Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order No.2 2007" and continues the restrictions currently in force at this location by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Wednesday, 30 May 2007 and shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Sunday, the second day of September, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-eighth day of October, two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Water's Flood Alleviation Scheme) on Hozier Street from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street to its junction with Whifflet Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed northwestwards on Wallace Street then eastwards on B753 Dundyvan Road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained by arrangement where practical.
