Deveron Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On 29 August 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on footway and carriageway repairs) on Deveron Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the west kerb of Rannoch Avenue to its junction with Tantallon Drive, a distance of 135 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on Tantallon Drive, southeastwards on Townhead Road, northeastwards on Leven Road then northwestwards and westwards on Deveron Street to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 10 September 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 28 September 2007.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Deveron Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the tenth day of September, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-eighth day of September, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on footway and carriageway repairs) on Deveron Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the west kerb of Rannoch Avenue to its junction with Tantallon Drive, a distance of 135 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure should proceed southwards on Tantallon Drive, southeastwards on Townhead Road, northeastwards on Leven Road then northwestwards and westwards on Deveron Street to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
