**A73 Luggiebank Slip Road**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007**

On 29 August 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and safety barrier works) on A73 Luggiebank Slip Road from its junction with A73 Stirling Road to its junction with Blackbog Road, a distance of 180 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access Blackbog Road should continue northwards and northwestwards on A73 Stirling Road, proceed around Lenziemill Roundabout and exit southeastwards on A73 Stirling Road continuing southeastwards and southwards on A73 Stirling Road to southbound off slip road then westwards on Blackbog Road to the north side of the closure.*

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 10 September 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 7 October 2007.

### **A73 Luggiebank Slip Road**

#### **(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Luggiebank Slip Road) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the tenth day of September, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the seventh day of October, two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and safety barrier works) on A73 Luggiebank Slip Road from its junction with A73 Stirling Road to its junction with Blackbog Road, a distance of 180 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access Blackbog Road should continue northwards and northwestwards on A73 Stirling Road, proceed around Lenziemill Roundabout and exit southeastwards on A73 Stirling Road continuing southeastwards and southwards on A73 Stirling Road to southbound off slip road then westwards on Blackbog Road to the north side of the closure.*
