Sunnyside Road & West Canal Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 26 September 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on utilities diversion works on Sunnyside Road & West Canal Street, Coatbridge) as specified on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge

From the extended line of the south-west kerb of Baird Street to its junction with the Fountain roundabout at Main Street, South Circular Road, Bank Street and West Canal Street, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, north-westwards then northwards on Dunbeth Road, eastwards then south-eastwards on Sunnyside Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

West Canal Street, Coatbridge

From the extended line of the east kerb of Heritage Way to its junction with the Fountain roundabout at Sunnyside Road, Main Street, South Circular Road and Bank Street, a distance of 65 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on West Canal Street, southwards on Blairhill Street, eastwards on A89 Bank Street to the east side of closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

During the works it may not be possible for vehicles from Whittington Street, or vehicles travelling to the service area at 18-82 Main Street to perform a U-Turn manoeuvre at the "Fountain" roundabout. To overcome this, the following Orders which prohibit the right turn from Whittington Street and from South Circular Road shall be temporarily revoked for the duration of this Order.

Schedule V of the Strathclyde Regional Council (Coatbridge Town Centre) (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order 1990 (which prohibits right-hand turns from Whittington Street to South Circular Road “only”) and The Strathclyde Regional Council (South Circular Road, Coatbridge) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turns) Order 1982 (which prohibits right-hand turns from South Circular Road, Coatbridge, to south-east of the rear service area of nos. 18-82 Main Street, will be temporarily revoked as part of this Order.

Pedestrian access shall be maintained at all times. However, it may be necessary to switch off the signalised pedestrian crossings from time to time.

The Order which will only be in operation when appropriate signing is in place and where existing “No Right Turn” signs are covered will come into operation at 0001 hours until 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays from Sunday, 7 October and will remain in operation until Sunday 9 December 2007.

Sunnyside Road & West Canal Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Sunnyside Road & West Canal Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be in operation when appropriate signing is in place and where existing “No Right Turn” signs are covered during the period from 0001 hours until 2359 hours on consecutive Sundays from Sunday, the seventh day of October, two thousand and seven until Sunday, the ninth day of December, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on utilities diversion works on Sunnyside Road & West Canal Street, Coatbridge) as specified on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge

From the extended line of the south-west kerb of Baird Street to its junction with the Fountain roundabout at Main Street, South Circular Road, Bank Street and West Canal Street, a distance of 180 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, north-westwards then northwards on Dunbeth Road, eastwards then south-eastwards on Sunnyside Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

West Canal Street, Coatbridge

From the extended line of the east kerb of Heritage Way to its junction with the Fountain roundabout at Sunnyside Road, Main Street, South Circular Road and Bank Street, a distance of 65 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on West Canal Street, southwards on Blairhill Street, eastwards on A89 Bank Street to the east side of closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

During the works it may not be possible for vehicles from Whittington Street, or vehicles travelling to the service area at 18-82 Main Street to perform a U-Turn manoeuvre at the "Fountain" roundabout. To overcome this, the following Orders which prohibit the right turn from Whittington Street and from South Circular Road shall be temporarily revoked for the duration of this Order.
