(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 3 October 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main replacement works on Towers Road, Airdrie) from the extended line of the northwest kerb of the access to Wester Moffat Hospital north-westwards to the extended line of the southeast kerb of Station Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road, westwards then south-westwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, eastwards then north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street and south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Access by emergency vehicles will not be permitted.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Saturday, 13 October 2007 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 21 October 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Towers Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Saturday, the thirteenth day of October, two thousand and seven until 1800 hours on Sunday, the twenty-first day of October, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main replacement works on Towers Road, Airdrie) from the extended line of the northwest kerb of the access to Wester Moffat Hospital north-westwards to the extended line of the southeast kerb of Station Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to travel to the northwest side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road, westwards then south-westwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, eastwards then north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street and south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Access by emergency vehicles will not be permitted.
