(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2007

On 17 October the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on the construction of a new road) on Loch Road, Stepps from its junction with Cumbernauld Road south-eastwards for a distance of 540 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on the A80 Cumbernauld Road, eastwards on Cardowan Drive, southwards on Cardowan Road, westwards on Clayhouse Road and northwards on Loch Road to the south side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, 28 October 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Monday, 14 April 2008.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Loch Road, Stepps) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Sunday, the twenty-eighth day of October, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Monday, the fourteenth day of April, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on the construction of a new road) on Loch Road, Stepps from its junction with Cumbernauld Road south-eastwards for a distance of 540 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on the A80 Cumbernauld Road, eastwards on Cardowan Drive, southwards on Cardowan Road, westwards on Clayhouse Road and northwards on Loch Road to the south side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
