Traquair Avenue, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

On Wednesday 31 October 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on Traquair Avenue, Wishaw from its junction with Coltness Road to its junction with Kilmeny Crescent, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed northwards on Coltness Road, eastwards on Hazeldean Crescent, and southwards then eastwards on Kilmeny Crescent to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained, where practical, by arrangement.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday 12 November 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday 2 December 2007.

It should be noted that the works are expected to be completed within two weeks.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Traquair Avenue, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twelve day of November, two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the second day of December, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on Traquair Avenue, from its junction with Coltness Road to its junction with Kilmeny Crescent, Wishaw by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed northwards on Coltness Road, eastwards on Hazeldean Crescent, and southwards then eastwards on Kilmeny Crescent to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to local properties will be maintained, where practical, by arrangement.
