**A71 Horsley Brae, Overtown**

**(Temporary 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2007**

On 31 October 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on A71 Horsley Brae, Overtown from the extended line of the south kerb of the B7011 Brownlee Road, southwestwards for a distance of 385 metres or thereby when signposted by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

It should be noted that the works are expected to be completed within 1 week.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday 12 November 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday 25 November 2007.

**(Temporary 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2007**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A71, Horsley Brae, Overtown) (Temporary 30 mph Speed restriction) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twelfth day of November two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty fifth day of November, Two thousand and seven.
  
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on A71 Horsley Brae, Overtown from the extended line of the south kerb of the B7011 Brownlee Road, southwestwards for a distance of 385 metres or thereby when signposted by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
