B803 Coatbridge Road, Glenmavis

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

On 31 October 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on B803 Coatbridge Road, Glenmavis from the extended line of the north-east kerb of Glenview Street south-westwards for a distance of 450 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the northeast side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B803 Coatbridge Road/Raebog Road, southwards on A73 Stirling Road, south-westwards on A8010 Black Street/Aitken Street/Chapel Street/East High Street/High Street/Aitchison Street and A89 Alexander Street/Deedes Street, westwards on A89 Main Street and B804 Main Street, northwards on B804 Dunbeth Road and north-eastwards on B803 Burnbank Street/Waverley Street and Coatbridge Road to the southwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be available by arrangement with the Contractor.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays from Saturday, 17 November 2007, and will remain in operation until Sunday, 9 December 2007.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B803 Coatbridge Road, Glenmavis) (Temporary Closure) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays from Saturday, the seventeenth day of November, two thousand and seven until Sunday, the ninth day of December, Two thousand and seven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on B803 Coatbridge Road, Glenmavis from the extended line of the north-east kerb of Glenview Street south-westwards for a distance of 450 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the northeast side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B803 Coatbridge Road/Raebog Road, southwards on A73 Stirling Road, south-westwards on A8010 Black Street/Aitken Street/Chapel Street/East High Street/High Street/Aitchison Street and A89 Alexander Street/Deedes Street, westwards on A89 Main Street and B804 Main Street, northwards on B804 Dunbeth Road and north-eastwards on B803 Burnbank Street/Waverley Street and Coatbridge Road to the southwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be available by arrangement with the Contractor.
