Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell

(Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2007

On 22 November 2007 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle in excess of 18 tonnes maximum gross weight (with the exception of vehicles engaged on structural assessment) on Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell from a point 50 metres north east of the extended northern kerb of Orbiston Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the restriction wishing to access the south east side of the restriction should proceed north-westwards on Park Street, north-eastwards on Albert Street, north-eastwards on Coursington Road, north-westwards on Allan Street, south-eastwards on Merry Street (A723), south-eastwards on Mentieth Road (A721) and south-eastwards on Brandon Street (A721) to the south-west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the restriction wishing to access the north east side of the restriction should proceed vice versa.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday 1 December 2007 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday 1 June 2008.

(Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2007

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2007” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday the first day of December two thousand and seven until 2359 hours on Sunday the first day of June, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle in excess of 18 tonnes maximum gross weight (with the exception of vehicles engaged on structural assessment) on Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell from a point 50 metres north east of the extended northern kerb of Orbiston Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the restriction wishing to access the south east side of the restriction should proceed north-westwards on Park Street, north-eastwards on Albert Street, north-eastwards on Coursington Road, north-westwards on Allan Street, south-eastwards on Merry Street (A723), south-eastwards on Mentieth Road (A721) and south-eastwards on Brandon Street (A721) to the south-west side of the closure.
