New Craig Road/Robberhall Road, Motherwell

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 9 January 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on utility works) on New Craig Road and Robberhall Road, Motherwell for their entirety by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles (15' (4.6m) or under in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A723 Merry Street, south-eastwards on A721 Mentieth Road, south-eastwards on A721 Brandon Street, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, and eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles (15' (4.6m) or under in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles (over 15' (4.6m) in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A723 Merry Street, south-eastwards on A721 Mentieth Road, south-eastwards on A721 Brandon Street, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, south-eastwards on B754 Shields Road, south-eastwards on B754 Netherton Road, southwards then south-westwards on B754 Castlehill Road, north-eastwards on A71 Main Street, north-eastwards on A71 Overtown Road, north-westwards on A721 Wishaw Road, north-westwards on A721 Stewarton Street, north-westwards on A721 Main Street, south-westwards on A721 Glasgow Road, north-westwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles (over 15' (4.6m) in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 21 January 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 30 March 2008.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (New Craig Road/Robberhall Road, Motherwell) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-first day of January, two thousand and eight until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirtieth day of March, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on utility works) on New Craig Road and Robberhall Road, Motherwell for their entirety by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles (15' (4.6m) or under in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A723 Merry Street, south-eastwards on A721 Mentieth Road, south-eastwards on A721 Brandon Street, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, and eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles (15' (4.6m) or under in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles (over 15' (4.6m) in height) on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on A723 Merry Street, south-eastwards on A721 Mentieth Road, south-eastwards on A721 Brandon Street, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, south-eastwards on B754 Shields Road, south-eastwards on B754 Netherton Road, southwards then south-westwards on B754 Castlehill Road, north-eastwards on A71 Main Street, north-eastwards on A71 Overtown Road, north-westwards on A721 Wishaw Road, north-westwards on A721 Stewarton Street, north-westwards on A721 Main Street, south-westwards on A721 Glasgow Road, north-westwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles (over 15' (4.6m) in height) on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
