

North Lanarkshire Council
Hospital Road, Pather
(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 23 January 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway repair works) on Hospital Road, Pather from its junction with Rannoch Drive north-eastwards for a distance of 140 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed westwards on Rannoch Drive, north-eastwards on Ness Street, eastwards on Linnhe Crescent to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.

The Order, which will only be in effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 4 February 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 24 February 2008.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hospital Road, Pather) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008” and will be effective only when displayed by signs, will come into operation on 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of February, two thousand and eight and continue until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty-fourth day of February, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway repair works) on Hospital Road, Pather from its junction with Rannoch Drive north-eastwards for a distance of 140 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed westwards on Rannoch Drive, north-eastwards on Ness Street, eastwards to Linnhe Crescent on the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.
