(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 26 March 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and patching works) on Northburn Street, Plains from its junction with Jarvie Avenue to its junction with A89 Main Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards then north-westwards on Jarvie Avenue, south-westwards on Wallace Street, south-eastwards on Bruce Street and north-eastwards on A89 Main Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 7 April 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 20 April 2008.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Northburn Street, Plains) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the seventh day of April, two thousand and eight until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twentieth day of April, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and patching works) on Northburn Street, Plains from its junction with Jarvie Avenue to its junction with A89 Main Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards then north-westwards on Jarvie Avenue, south-westwards on Wallace Street, south-eastwards on Bruce Street and north-eastwards on A89 Main Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Diversion routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
