**Footpath on Loch Road, Stepps**

**(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2008**

On 21 May 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of those engaged on the construction of a new road) on Loch Road, Stepps from its junction with A80 Cumbernauld Road south-eastwards for a distance of 540 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road, eastwards on Cardowan Drive, southwards on Cardowan Road, south-westwards, southwards and south-westwards on Clayhouse Road and northwards on Loch Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The Order will come into operation at 0900 hours on Monday, 2 June 2008 and will remain in operation until 1700 hours on Sunday, 30 November 2008.

### Footpath on Loch Road, Stepps

#### (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Footpath on Loch Road, Stepps) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2008" and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Monday, the second day of June, two thousand and eight until 1700 hours on Sunday, the thirtieth day of November, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of those engaged on the construction of a new road) on Loch Road, Stepps from its junction with A80 Cumbernauld Road, south-eastwards for a distance of 540 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road, eastwards on Cardowan Drive, southwards on Cardowan Road, south-westwards, southwards and south-westwards on Clayhouse Road and northwards on Loch Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*
