

North Lanarkshire Council
Woodside Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 22 May 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacement works) on Woodside Street from its junction with A89 Bank Street/Glasgow Road southwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Allan Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Woodside Street, south-eastwards then eastwards on Kirkshaws Road, northwards on Whifflet Street continuing northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards then north-westwards on South Circular Road and then south-westwards on Bank Street to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 2 June 2008 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 15 June 2008.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Woodside Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the second day of June, two thousand and eight until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fifteenth day of June, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacement works) on Woodside Street from its junction with A89 Bank Street/Glasgow Road southwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Allan Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Woodside Street, south-eastwards then eastwards on Kirkshaws Road, northwards on Whifflet Street continuing northwards on Coatbank Street, westwards then north-westwards on South Circular Road and then south-westwards on Bank Street to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
