Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell

(Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2008

On 21 August 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle in excess of 18 tonnes maximum gross weight on Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell from a point 50 metres north east of the extended line of the northern kerb of Orbiston Street, north eastwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:-

Vehicles in excess of 18 tonnes on the north east side of the restriction wishing to access the south west side of the restriction should proceed north eastwards on Crosshill Street, north westwards on Park Street, north eastwards on Albert Street, eastwards on Coursington Road, north westwards on Allan Street, south westwards on A723 Merry Street, south eastwards on A721 Menteith Road, south eastwards on A721 Brandon Street and north eastwards on Crosshill Street to the south west side of the restriction.

Vehicles in excess of 18 tonnes on the south west side of the restriction wishing to access the north east side of the restriction should proceed vice-versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 1 September 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 1 March 2009.

(Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2008" and be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the First day of September, Two thousand and eight until 2359 hours on Sunday, the First day of March, Two Thousand and Nine.
- (2) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle in excess of 18 tonnes maximum gross weight on Crosshill Street Railway Bridge, Motherwell from a point 50 metres north east of the extended line of the northern kerb of Orbiston Street, north eastwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby..
