(Stewart Crescent/Eastwood Drive, Newmains)

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 27 August 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the drainage system upgrade works on Westwood Road) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

Stewart Crescent, Newmains from its junction with A73 Westwood Road, south westwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:- Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access A73 Westwood Road should proceed south westwards then north westwards on Stewart Crescent, north eastwards on King Street and south eastwards on Murdostoun View to A73 Westwood Road.

Vehicles on A73 Westwood Road wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

Eastwood Drive, Newmains from its junction with A73 Westwood Road, north eastwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:- Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Westwood Road should proceed north eastwards, northwards, north eastwards then north westwards on Eastwood Drive to A73 Westwood Road.

Vehicles on A73 Westwood Road wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained by arrangement with the contractor.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 8 September 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 5 October 2008.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Stewart Crescent/Eastwood Drive, Newmains) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008" and be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the Eighth day of September until 2359 hours on Sunday, the Fifth day of October 2008.

No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the drainage system upgrade works on Westwood Road) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

Stewart Crescent, Newmains from its junction with A73 Westwood Road, south westwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:- Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access A73 Westwood Road should proceed south westwards then north westwards on Stewart Crescent, north eastwards on King Street and south eastwards on Murdostoun View to A73 Westwood Road.

Vehicles on A73 Westwood Road wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

Eastwood Drive, Newmains from its junction with A73 Westwood Road, north eastwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes:- Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Westwood Road should proceed north eastwards, northwards, north eastwards then north westwards on Eastwood Drive to A73 Westwood Road.

Vehicles on A73 Westwood Road wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained by arrangement with the contractor.
