B803 Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 24 September 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on B803 Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge from the extended line of the western kerb of B804 Dunbeth Road south-eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Gartsherrie Road, a distance of 355 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Northbound vehicles on the south-west side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Gartsherrie Road, north-eastwards on Blane Street, eastwards on West George Street, south-eastwards on B804 Coltswood Road and south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.

Northbound vehicles on the north-east side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, westwards on Russell Colt Street and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Southbound vehicles on the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards then south-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, south-eastwards then eastwards on A89 South Circular Road then north-westwards and northwards on B804 Dunbeth Road to the north-east side of the closure.

Southbound vehicles on the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Crichton Street should proceed south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-eastwards on Baird Street, northwards on Church Street and eastwards on Albert Street to Crichton Street.

Vehicles on Crichton Street wishing to access the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access Crichton Street should proceed southwards on Dunbeth Road, and south-westwards on Colt Terrace to Crichton Street.

Vehicles on Crichton Street wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays from Saturday, 4 October 2008 and will remain in operation until Sunday, 19 October 2008.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B803 Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays from Saturday, the fourth day of October, two thousand and eight until Sunday, the nineteenth day of October, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on B803 Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge from the extended line of the western kerb of B804 Dunbeth Road south-eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Gartsherrie Road, a distance of 355 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Northbound vehicles on the south-west side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Gartsherrie Road, north-eastwards on Blane Street, eastwards on West George Street, south-eastwards on B804 Coltswood Road and south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road to the north-east side of the closure.

Northbound vehicles on the north-east side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, westwards on Russell Colt Street and south-eastwards on Gartsherrie Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Southbound vehicles on the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-westwards then south-eastwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, south-eastwards then eastwards on A89 South Circular Road then north-westwards and northwards on B804 Dunbeth Road to the north-east side of the closure.

Southbound vehicles on the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Crichton Street should proceed south-westwards on B803 Sunnyside Road, north-eastwards on Baird Street, northwards on Church Street and eastwards on Albert Street to Crichton Street.

Vehicles on Crichton Street wishing to access the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access Crichton Street should proceed southwards on Dunbeth Road, and south-westwards on Colt Terrace to Crichton Street.

Vehicles on Crichton Street wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.
