

North Lanarkshire Council
Kirkshaws Road, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 1 October 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage connection works) on Kirkshaws Road from the extended line of the western kerb of Scarhill Street, north-westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards then northwards on Kirkshaws Road, north-eastwards on Old Monkland Road, north-eastwards on School Street, southwards on Whifflet Street and south-westwards on Kirkshaws Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 13 October 2008 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 19 October 2008.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Kirkshaws Road, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of October, two thousand and eight until 1800 hours on Sunday, the nineteenth day of October, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage connection works) on Kirkshaws Road from the extended line of the western kerb of Scarhill Street, north-westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards then northwards on Kirkshaws Road, north-eastwards on Old Monkland Road, north-eastwards on School Street, southwards on Whifflet Street and south-westwards on Kirkshaws Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.
