

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie**  
**(Temporary Closure) Order 2008**

On 8 October 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of Howletnest Road south-westwards then north-westwards to its junction with A73 Carlisle Road, a distance of 297 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Southbound vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, north-westwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards then north-westwards on Willow Drive and south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel northwards at the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Northbound vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street, south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road, south-westwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, north-westwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards then north-westwards on Willow Drive and south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel southwards at the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Diversion route(s) will be signposted.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will be effective only on Sundays from 0001 hours until 2359 hours, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, 19 October 2008 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 7 December 2008.

**(Temporary Closure) Order 2008**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008" and shall be effective only on Sundays from 0001 hours until 2359 hours, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday the nineteenth day of October, two thousand and eight and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, the seventh day of December, Two thousand and eight.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Craigneuk Avenue, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of Howletnest Road south-westwards then north-westwards to its junction with A73 Carlisle Road, a distance of 297 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Southbound vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, north-westwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards then north-westwards on Willow Drive and south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel northwards at the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Northbound vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street, south-eastwards on B8058 Towers Road, south-westwards on B8058 Petersburn Road, north-westwards on Bankhead Avenue, south-westwards then north-westwards on Willow Drive and south-westwards on Craigneuk Avenue to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel southwards at the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Diversion route(s) will be signposted.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.
