(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

On 10 December 2008 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of new public utilities associated with Ravenscraig project) on Glasgow Road, Wishaw from a point 50 metres east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bridge Street, north-westwards a distance of 175 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles of a height 15' or under on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on A721 Glasgow Road, south-westwards on Netherton Street, north westwards on B754 Netherton Road and Shields Road, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street and Craigneuk Street and south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road to the north-west side of the closure.

Vehicles of a height 15' or under on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles of a height in excess of 15' on the south east of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed eastwards then north-eastwards on A721 Glasgow Road, south-eastwards on A721 Main Street, A721 Stewarton Street, and A721 Wishaw Road, south-westwards on A71 Overtown Road and A71 Main Street, north-westwards on B754 Castlehill Road, B754 Netherton Road and B754 Shields Road, westwards and north-westwards on A721 Windmillhill Street and A721 Brandon Street, northwards on A721 Menteith Road, north-eastwards on A723 Merry Street, southwards on New Craig Road and Robberhall Road, eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street and south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road to the north-west side of the closure.

Vehicles of a height in excess of 15' on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday 10 January 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday 6 February 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2008

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Glasgow Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Closure) Order 2008" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the tenth day of January, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the sixth day of February, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of new public utilities associated with Ravenscraig project) on Glasgow Road, Wishaw from a point 50 metres east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bridge Street, north-westwards for a distance of 175 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles of a height 15' or under on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on A721 Glasgow Road, south-westwards on Netherton Street, north westwards on B754 Netherton Road and Shields Road, eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street and Craigneuk Street and south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road to the north-west side of the closure.

Vehicles of a height 15' or under on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles of a height in excess of 15' on the south east of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed eastwards then north-eastwards on A721 Glasgow Road, south-eastwards on A721 Main Street, A721 Stewarton Street, and A721 Wishaw Road, south-westwards on A71 Overtown Road and A71 Main Street, north-westwards on B754 Castlehill Road, B754 Netherton Road and B754 Shields Road, westwards and north-westwards on A721 Windmillhill Street and A721 Brandon Street, northwards on A721 Menteith Road, north-eastwards on A723 Merry Street, southwards on New Craig Road and Robberhall Road, eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street and south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road to the north-west side of the closure.

Vehicles of a height in excess of 15' on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
