

North Lanarkshire Council
Rosehall Road, Shotts
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 21 January 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacements work) on Rosehall Road, Shotts from the extended line of the southern kerb of Currieside Avenue, south-westwards for a distance of 350m or thereby reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the northeast side of the closure should proceed northeast-wards on Rosehall Road, eastwards on Station Road, south eastwards then south-westwards on Burnbrae Road, south-westwards on A71 Allanton Road, north-eastwards on Mill Road and Hartwood Road, eastwards on Bowhousebog Road and north-eastwards on Rosehall Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to local premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order, which will be effective only when signing is in place, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 2 February 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Monday, 2 March 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Rosehall Road, Shotts) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the second day of February, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Monday, the second day of March, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas mains replacements work) on Rosehall Road, Shotts from the extended line of the southern kerb of Currieside Avenue, south-westwards a distance of 350m or there by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the northeast side of the closure should proceed northeast-wards on Rosehall Road, eastwards on Station Road, south eastwards then south-westwards on Burnbrae Road, south-westwards on A71 Allanton Road, north-eastwards on Mill Road and Hartwood Road, eastwards on Bowhousebog Road and north-eastwards on Rosehall Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehiclular access to local premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure
