(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 28 January 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of New Traffic Signals and associated carriageway widening works) on B754 Shields Road, Motherwell from the extended line of the northern kerb of Range Road north-westwards then north-eastwards to its junction with Windmillhill Street a distance of 340 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles under 15' in height on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, eastwards then south-eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street, south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road, south-westwards on Netherton Street, north-westwards on B754 Netherton Road and north-westwards on B754 Shields Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles under 15' in height on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles in excess of 15' in height on the north side of the closure, wishing access to the south side of the closure should proceed westwards then north-westwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, north-westwards on A721 Brandon Street, north-westwards on A721 Mentieth Road north-eastwards on A723 Merry Street, southwards on New Craig Road, southwards on Robberhall Road, eastwards then south-eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street, south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street, south-eastwards then north-eastwards on A721 Glasgow Road, south-eastwards on A721 Main Street, A721 Stewarton Street and A721 Wishaw Road, south-westwards on A71 Overtown Road and A71 Main Street , north-westwards on B754 Castlehill Road, north-westwards on B754 Netherton Road and north-westwards on B754 Shields Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles in excess of 15' in height on the south side of the closure wishing access to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 9 February 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 8 March 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Shields Road, Motherwell) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the ninth day of February, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of March, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of New Traffic Signals and associated carriageway widening works) on B754 Shields Road, Motherwell from the extended line of the northern kerb of Range Road north-westwards then north-eastwards to its junction with Windmillhill Street a distance of 340 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles under 15' in height on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed eastwards on A721 Windmillhill Street, eastwards then south-eastwards on A721 Craigneuk Street, south-eastwards on A721 Shieldmuir Street and A721 Glasgow Road, south-westwards on Netherton Street, north-westwards on B754 Netherton Road and north-westwards on B754 Shields Road to the south side of the closure.
