A725 Whifflet Street and Hozier Street, Coatbridge

(Temporary Closures) Order 2009

On 4 February 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway construction works) on the under noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

A725 Whifflet Street from the extended line of the southern kerb of Caldeen Road, southwards to the extended lines of the northern kerb of School Street and Calder Street.

Location 2

Hozier Street from its junction with Whifflet Street westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on B753 Calder Street and north westwards on Caldeen Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Wallace Street, westwards then north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street and north-eastwards on School Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Wallace Street, westwards then north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street, north-eastwards on School Street, north-eastwards on B753 Calder Street and north-westwards on Caldeen Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closures.

Vehicular access to local premises will be maintained by arrangement where practical, with the contractor.

The Order, which will be effective only on Sundays, between the hours of 0001 hours and 2359 hours, will come into operation on 0001 hours on Sunday, 15 February 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 15 March 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A725 Whifflet Street and Hozier Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and which shall be effective only on Sundays from 0001 hours until 2359 hours, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, the fifteenth day of February, Two thousand and nine and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fifteenth day of March, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway construction works) on the under noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

A725 Whifflet Street from the extended line of the southern kerb of Caldeen Road, southwards to the extended lines of the northern kerb of School Street and Calder Street.

Location 2

Hozier Street from its junction with Whifflet Street westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Wallace Street.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B753 Calder Street and north-westwards on Caldeen Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Wallace Street, westwards then north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street and north-eastwards on School Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Wallace Street, westwards then north-westwards on Dundyvan Road, south-westwards then south-eastwards on Barrowfield Street, north-eastwards on School Street, north-eastwards on B753 Calder Street and north-westwards on Caldeen Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closures.

Vehicular access to local premises will be maintained by arrangement, where practical, with the contractor.
