

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Langloan Street, Coatbridge**  
**(Temporary Closure) Order 2009**

On 18 February 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer works) on Langloan Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Kirkwood Street, eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on Kirkwood Street, north-eastwards on Bank Street and southwards then south-westwards on Langloan Street to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 2 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Friday, 22 May 2009.

**(Temporary Closure) Order 2009**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Langloan Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the second day of March, two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Friday, the twenty-second day of May, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer works) on Langloan Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Kirkwood Street, eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed northwards on Kirkwood Street, north-eastwards on Bank Street and southwards then south-westwards on Langloan Street to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.
