

North Lanarkshire Council
Auchengeich Road, Moodiesburn
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 18 February 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of a new overbridge) on Auchengeich Road, Moodiesburn from a point 390 metres or thereby north-west of its junction with Gartferry Road, north-westwards to its junction with Muckcroft Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the south-east side of the closure should proceed westwards and north-westwards on Muckcroft Road, northwards and north-eastwards on Calemuir Road, north-westwards and northwards on Market Road, north-eastwards on B8048 Waterside Road and Kirkintilloch Road, south-eastwards and southwards on Mollins Road, south-westwards on Gartferry Road and north-westwards on Auchengeich Road to the south-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south-east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Access to the adjacent agricultural fields will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday 1 March 2009 and will remain in operation until the construction of the overbridge has been completed.

The Council is satisfied that these works will exceed a period of eighteen months.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Auchengeich Road, Moodiesburn) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Sunday, the first day of March, two thousand and nine until the construction of the overbridge has been completed.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of a new overbridge) on Auchengeich Road, Moodiesburn from a point 390 metres or thereby north-west of its junction with Gartferry Road, north-westwards to its junction with Muckcroft Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access the south-east side of the closure should proceed westwards and north-westwards on Muckcroft Road, northwards and north-eastwards on Calemuir Road, north-westwards and northwards on Market Road, north-eastwards on B8048 Waterside Road and Kirkintilloch Road, south-eastwards and southwards on Mollins Road, south-westwards on Gartferry Road and north-westwards on Auchengeich Road to the south-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south-east side of the closure wishing to access the north-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Access to the adjacent agricultural fields will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Council is satisfied that these works will exceed a period of eighteen months.
