Roundknowe Road, Uddingston
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 19 February 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge strengthening works) on Roundknowe Road, Uddingston over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

There are no alternative routes.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Order will be effective on weekdays only, from 0930 hours until 1530 hours and will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 2 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 1530 hours on Friday, 20 March 2009.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Roundknowe Road, Uddingston) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the periods from 0930 hours on Mondays until 1530 hours on Fridays from Monday, the second day of March, Two thousand and nine until Friday, the twentieth day of March, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge strengthening works) on Roundknowe Road, Uddingston over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

There are no alternative routes.
