

North Lanarkshire Council
Locks Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 13 March 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main installation works) on Locks Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 360 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Locks Street, south-westwards on Calder Street, north-westwards on Caldeen Road, northwards on Coatbank Street and south-eastwards then north-eastwards on Main Street to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained where possible.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 23 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 19 April 2009.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Locks Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the twenty-third day of March, two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Sunday, the nineteenth day of April, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main installation works) on Locks Street, Coatbridge from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 360 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed southwards on Locks Street, south-westwards on Calder Street, north-westwards on Caldeen Road, northwards on Coatbank Street and south-eastwards then north-eastwards on Main Street to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained where possible.
